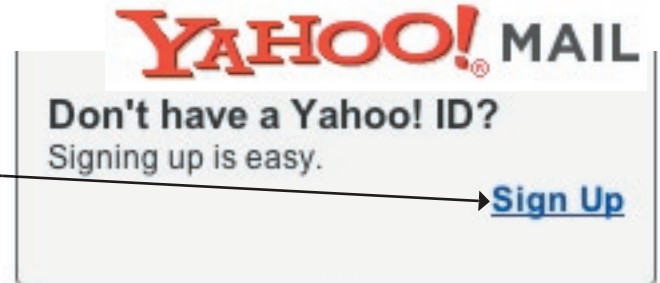


HOW TO SET UP A WEB BASED YAHOO! MAIL ACCOUNT

Yahoo! Mail allows you to set up a free web based E-mail account. This means that you can access your Yahoo! Mail account anywhere you can access the internet. You can even set up multiple accounts to use for different purposes (i.e. one for personal correspondence and one for professional use. Make sure you sign in to your account at least once during the first week and at least once a month there after or your account may become deactivated and you may lose any E-mail message you may have.

HOW TO SIGN UP

1. Go to **http://mail.yahoo.com**
2. Click the blue **Sign Up** link.
3. Fill in all the required information.



Your Yahoo! ID will be your E-mail address/user name. If you enter “john” as your Yahoo! ID, your E-mail address will be “john@yahoo.com”. Be sure and remember your Yahoo! ID and password as you will need them to sign in and check your E-mail. A space is provided below to write them down if you wish.

You will also be asked a few questions under **If You Forget Your Password...** including your ZIP code, birthday and a security question. Be sure to remember the answers to these questions, because if you ever forget your password you will need these to reset it. *NOTE: If you forget your password and the answers you entered here, you will not be able to access your account or retrieve any E-mail.*

4. Under **Verify Your Registration** be sure to enter the code you see below the box. The numbers and letters may look funny in the box but they should be legible enough for you to read them, this is done to prevent automatic registration.
5. Click the **I Agree** button at the bottom of the page when finished.
6. If the Yahoo! ID you selected is not available, it will ask you to pick another Yahoo! ID.
7. Click the **Continue to Yahoo! Mail** button.

That's it! You now have a Yahoo! Mail Account.
